<p><i>Notes: The bread you bake with your hands becomes the Body of Christ. What a great privilege! What a beautiful gift you present to the Lord!</i> <i>Of course, the Prosforon/Prosfora should always be fresh – <u>never</u> frozen – since it is given as a precious gift to God to become His Immaculate Body.</i> <i>The Prosforon/Prosfora is/are needed at church in advance of the scheduled Liturgy.</i> <i>The Priest starts the Service of the Proskomidi <u>before</u> Matins, so bringing the Prosforon/Prosfora to church the evening before is a good guideline to follow.</i> <i>On Sundays, two loaves are normally required to ensure we have enough both for the Oblation and for Antidoron.</i> <i>On Weekdays a small loaf suffices:</i> ¹ <i>One small Prosforon will be sufficient.</i> ² <i>For the early Morning Liturgies, the small Prosforon must be at church the previous evening.</i></p>
